#### Feedback Report - Academic Year 2023-24

#### **Introduction:**

K.G. Joshi College of Arts & N.G. Bedekar College of Commerce was the first institution of higher learning to be established in Thane City in 1969. Strategically located, the college is at walking distance from Thane Railway Station on the Central Railway line. It is well connected by bus services to every part of the city including Navi Mumbai.

The College received permanent affiliation in January 1988 with effect from June 1982. The college was re-accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Banglore and awarded 'A' grade in January 2011 (2nd cycle) and subsequently has awarded 'A' grade in November 2016 during 3rd cycle.

The College was designated as one of the Community Colleges of the University of Mumbai and has got the Best College Award of University of Mumbai (2011-12). The College is also ISO 9001-2015 Certified. The college was granted Autonomous Status, implemented from the Academic year 2021-22.

The college has entered into multiple collaborations with Institutions of repute, industries, NGOs and so on which is in tune with the mission of - 'To impart holistic education to students through experiential learning, outreach activities and pursuit of universal value'.

From a society point of view, college is a hub of education and thereby means of socio-economic development. 
#### Part- A Students' Feedback on Teachers


In Total **2519** students gave the feedback and the detailed findings on above parameters are as follows:

#### 1. Accessibility / Availability (उपलब्धता)




Majority of the students felt that accessibility of teachers was excellent (23.3%), very good (29.7%) and Good (35%). While less than 12% felt it at an average and fair level during the academic year.

### 2. Completion of syllabus (अभ्यासक्रम पूर्तता)





## 3. Discipline (शिस्त)





## 4. Explanation / Expressiveness (स्पष्टीकरण)





## 5. Illustration of concept (उदाहरणासहीत स्पष्टीकरण)





## 6. Method of Teaching (शिकवण्याची पद्धत)





#### 7. Practice and Revision (सराव)





## 8. Punctuality (वक्तशीरपणा)





### 10. Temperament (स्वभाव)




A bi-lingual multi-point Students' Feedback on Syllabus was conducted for 2260 students covering following questions-

### 1. Syllabus has current contents (अभ्यासक्रमात सध्याची सामग्री आहे)







## 3. Curriculum helps in developing personality (अभ्यासक्रम व्यक्तिमत्त्व विकसित करण्यास मदत करतो)




53.1% students felt that the curriculum helps in developing personality excellently, 32.7% of the students felt that it is good and only a few 14.2% students felt it is average.

### 4. Curriculum enhances employability (अभ्यासक्रम रोजगार वाढवते)




56.3% of students have given a good ranking for curriculum enhancing employability and 25.6% of the students have given excellent rating and 18.2% students felt it is average.

### 6. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? / वर्गात अभ्यासक्रम पूर्ण होतो का?





1. Have you participated in the designing of syllabus? (College or University or both) 64 responses




Majority (96.90%) of teachers participated in the designing of the syllabus during the academic year.

# 2. Are the objectives of the syllabus clearly stated? 64 responses




All (100%) teachers agreed that the objectives of the syllabus clearly stated during the academic year.

# 3. Does syllabus accurately describe the course? 64 responses




Majority (100%) of teachers agreed that the syllabus accurately describe the course during the academic year.

4. Do contents of the syllabus help in analysis and problem solving? 64 responses




Majority (100%) of teachers agreed that the syllabus helps in analysis and problem solving during the academic year.

# Does syllabus offer research possibilities? 64 responses




Majority (96.90%) of teachers agreed that the syllabus offer research possibilities during the academic year.

# 6. Does syllabus entail reference work? 64 responses




Majority (96.90%) of teachers agreed that the syllabus entails reference work during the academic year.

7. Does syllabus provide an opportunity to the students to undertake Community Projects? 64 responses




Majority (89.10%) of teachers agreed that the syllabus provide an opportunity to the students to undertake Community projects during the academic year.

8. Is there availability of useful textbooks and reference books covering the topics? 64 responses




Majority (95.3%) of teachers agreed that there is availability of useful textbooks and reference books covering the topics during the academic year.

# 9. Is time allotted sufficient to complete the syllabus? 64 responses




Majority (100%) of teachers agreed that the time allotted is sufficient to complete the syllabus during the academic year.

## 10. Is the content covered in the course reasonable? 64 responses




Majority (100%) of teachers agreed that the content is covered in the course reasonable during the academic year.

Majority (79.70%) of teachers agreed that the level of skills/knowledge required to complete the course is challenging during the academic year.










































Majority of the alumni shown their satisfaction towards adequacy of syllabus i.e. 42.10% with Very Good response and 44.50% with good response

## 2 Subject Knowledge covered 665 responses




According to the majority of the Alumni i.e.41.10% and 44.50% subject knowledge cover was of very good and good level.

## 3 Sequence of the courses selected during the program 665 responses




More than 85% of the alumni are satisfied with the sequence of the courses selected by them with very good and good responses

# 4 Structure of syllabus stipulated for the program 665 responses





# 5 Availability of materials and references related to syllabus 665 responses







# 6 Syllabus in tune with current trends 665 responses





# 7 Syllabus relevant to job market and future aspirations 665 responses





# 8 Syllabus helps in improving soft skills 665 responses








